### Firearms Act Amendments

Both houses of parliament recently grappled with amendments to the Firearms Act 1996. SSAA members were comprehensively represented by State officers who briefed parliamentary members on issues that concerned all shooters. During debate, parliamentarians of every persuasion often referred to information provided to them by Donald and his team.

During debate, it was recorded that the criminal element is compiling lists of firearm owners from various sources including publications such as our own *Bull Barrel*. With this in mind, lists of names won't be published in this or future editions. It is disappointing that we can't celebrate achievement in the same ways available to other sporting organisations.

One significant outcome of changes to the Act is that requirements for firearm storage will now be specified by regulation rather than being defined in the Act itself. These regulations should be published within the next year and will most likely impact on all firearm owners. It might be prudent to wait for more detail before upgrading storage facilities.

## Range News



A dedicated team has made wonderful progress to make sure that the AIF Range meets Range Approval requirements and National specifications for the National Junior Challenge. The height of an existing berm has been increased to provide an even safer environment and the 50m targets have been adjusted to meet national standards.

The *Mitchell Range Shelter and Storage Project* received tremendous support recently when the Club secured a Major Grant from CSRT. The Club expects to gain council approval for the project once the Interim Planning Scheme comes into effect allowing the Club to utilise the change in zoning. Hopefully the six year wait will soon be a thing of the past.

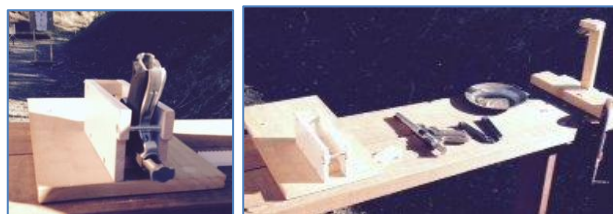
