The ShredTyre Project has been completed, inspected, and approved.

In October, the club lodged an application for a \$500,000 Community Sport and Recreation Major Grant to fund Stage 1 of the Mitchell Range Master Plan.

Stage 1 includes extra passing bays on the track, a new car park, three new ranges and water and power connections. It also includes design and drafting work, and a Development Application. The grant application outcome should be known before 22nd February 2022.
