Working Bee

Next working bee is on 31st July at both ranges.

The working bees at both ranges on 29th May were patronised by a few more workers than usual which is pleasing. Consequently, much more could be achieved. A clean-up was required at the MR after the recent maintenance and development work on the ranges and piles of FCR were spread.



The AIF team installed rope light along firing line, repaired gutter brackets, hung a "Welcome" sign, mowed grass, brush cut reeds and weeds, re-organised shipping containers, repaired gravel paths, installed a new cordial fridge, re-located rifle boxes, split and stacked firewood and generally had a good clean-up.

MR Range News

Unfortunately, the club was unsuccessful in its application for a \$500,000 *Community Sport and Recreation Major Grant* to fund *Stage 1* of the *Mitchell Range Master Plan*. This was extremely disappointing to the team that volunteered many hours of demanding work to put the application together. Feedback listed a lack of financial support from SSAA Tas and GCC as the main weaknesses of the application. Work will continue to develop and implement a *Mitchell Range Master Plan*.

Negotiations are continuing with GCC to finalise the 10+10-year lease for the MR.



The small butt in front of the left-hand side of the Range A target line has been removed to provide better access.



A new *Unibase* target system is in use on Range C and more bases have been commissioned for Steel Challenge and IPSC. Thanks to Frank, Paul D, Dawson and the rest of the team who have donated their time and skill to construct the bases and posts.



Also, thanks to Colin, Paul H and Shaun for giving Ranges A and B a touch-up and Range C a makeover, including repairing the berms and butt. Good job.

AIF Range News

The electrical works contracted out have nearly been completed with only two components still to be done. Discipline Captains please note that the new flashing red light on the building, to be used when night shooting, is plugged in where the old one used to be. The stainless steel cordial fridge has been replaced with a more contemporary glassed door model. This fridge was obtained as a donation to the club.

At the recent working bee, three of the wall mounted rifle boxes were relocated to the wall beside the firing line door. This was done to provide improved security of firearms whilst participants are out of the building.

SSAA Tasmania has requested that T03 Glenorchy host the 2022 Field Rifle and 3 Positional State Championships for both rimfire and centrefire. Details are yet to be finalised, but it is proposed the competition will be run over one weekend with rimfire at the AIF Range and centrefire at the state shooting complex at Runnymede.
